


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant



1 WHEREAS, Block Grant appropriations have been proposed for FY-1985 for  
2 several state programs including Energy Assistance Block Grant for  
3 Low Income Home Energy Assistance; and  
4 WHEREAS, The Low Income Home Energy Assistance is available through the  
5 Arizona Department of Economic Security, Block Grants Administration  
6 to Indian Tribes meeting certain eligibility requirements; and  
7 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe to apply for FY-1985  
8 Low Income Home Energy Assistance grant; and  
9 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe believes that it will satisfy the eligibility  
10 criteria set forth in the funding regulations.  
11 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize the  
12 officials of the Papago Tribe to submit a request for Low Income  
13 Home Energy Assistance Block Grant funding from Arizona Department  
14 of Economic Security, Block Grants Administration.  
15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice  
16 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are hereby  
17 authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary documents to  
18 request FY-1985 funding for Low Income Energy Assistance Block Grant.  
19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
20 day of December, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
21 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c) and (d) of Article V  
23 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
the Papago Council.
