

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Rejection of Selection/Recommendation of Perry Parton for
Papago Agency Superintendent

Res. No. 246-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised by the Bureau of Indian Affairs,
2 Phoenix Area Office Director, Mr. James Stevens of the Bureau's
3 decision to assign Mr. Perry Parton as Superintendent of Papago
4 Agency; and

5 WHEREAS, The Deputy Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs, Mr. John Fritz
6 advised that the appointment would be effective only if the Papago
7 Tribe agreed; and

8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council had established a review committee charged with the
9 responsibility of reviewing the applicants certified by the Bureau of
10 Indian Affairs as qualified to serve as Superintendents; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Parton was on the certified list and was reviewed by the review
12 committee and found not meeting the desirable qualifications wanted
13 by the Papago Tribe; and

14 WHEREAS, It would be in the Papago Tribe's best interest to require that the
15 mechanism available to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to recruit as
16 qualified applicants be utilized.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby reject
18 the appointment of Perry Parton as Papago Agency Superintendent, and
19 that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby directed to utilize the
20 skills bank to identify and recruit a qualified applicant, and if
21 there is no applicant available that the position be advertised to
22 attract qualified applicants.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
24 day of December, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
25 of 1232.0 for; -0- against; 208.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
26 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (d) Section 3
27 (d) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of
28 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
29 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
30 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
31 effective as of the date of its approval by the Papago Agency Superintendent and
32 is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
