

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Rescinding Ordinance No. 24 of the Papago Council)

Res. No. 247-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did on August 6, 1954, enact Ordinance No. 24
2 Land Code - Sif Oidak District; and

3 WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District Council did on April 9, 1983, enact Resolution
4 No. 03-83, a copy of which is attached hereto, requesting that the
5 Papago Council revoke and cancel Ordinance No. 24 because the
6 purposes of the Land Code have been defeated and assessing that the
7 owners of homes which are located on lands subject to standard land
8 assignments issued under the Land Code will be permitted to continue
9 to own, occupy and use such homes either under existing and valid
10 leases or under customary homesite assignments of the District; and

11 WHEREAS, The Papago Council concurs with the findings and conclusions of the
12 Sif Oidak District Council.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby revoke
14 and cancel Ordinance No. 24, subject to the terms and conditions of
15 Resolution No. 03-83 of the Sif Oidak District Council, and that it
16 does hereby request the Papago Agency and any persons claiming valid
17 leases or assignments to provide the District Council with all
18 information, evidence and opinions necessary to verify the validity
19 of any existing leases and of any homesite or land assignments issued
20 under the Ordinance.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
22 day of December, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
23 of 712.5 for; 315.5 against; 412.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
24 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c) and Section 3 (d)
25 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of
26 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
27 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
28 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
29 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
30 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
