

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Transfer of South Hickiwan)
(Funds to Ajo Bank)

RES. NO. 24-84

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WHEREAS, the Papago Constitution, Article V, Section 3 (a), provides that the Papago Council shall have control of all tribal funds and share appropriate such funds for . . . expenses of public business; and
WHEREAS, the Papago Council annually appropriates and approves funds for the various Districts for yearly expenditures in accordance with approved budgets; and
WHEREAS, the Papago Districts have authority to govern themselves in local matters and may themselves appropriate funds from their District budget to villages within their District; and
WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council appropriated funds to seven villages within their District; and
WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District funds are deposited in the Bureau of Indian Affairs - I.I.M. Office in Sells; and
WHEREAS, the South Hickiwan Community as a village appropriated funds for community use and it desires to withdraw its appropriated funds from the I.I.M. account to deposit in the Ajo Valley National; and
WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council has discussed and approved the withdrawal by the South Hickiwan Community Affairs Committee.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve the transfer of South Hickiwan Community funds on deposit in Sells, at the Bureau of Indian Affairs - I.I.M. Office to the Ajo Valley National Bank.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th day of February, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2, Article IV, Section 2 (f) and (m), Section 3 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
