

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Appointing Two Health Board Members


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 122-84 appoint such members  
2 to the Community Health Board as it felt would represent both the  
3 interests of the Tribe and the Health Professionals; and  
4 WHEREAS, Two members appointed to the Board have not become active members of  
5 the Board and have not officially accepted the nomination to sit as  
6 members; and  
7 WHEREAS, Both members are employees of the Indian Health Service and there is  
8 some question whether employees of the Indian Health Service can sit  
9 as policy making members of the Community Health Board; and  
10 WHEREAS, The Board, as presently constituted, recommends to the Papago Council  
11 that Andrew Lorentine and Irene Wallace, community at large represen-  
12 tatives be appointed to represent the health professions and two  
13 new persons be nominated to fill the vacancies left by this transfer.  
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve  
15 the appointment of Andrew Lorentine and Irene Wallace as representat-  
16 ives of the health professions to sit as members of the Community  
17 Health Board.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th  
19 day of December, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
20 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -2- absent, pursuant to the  
21 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) of Article V of the  
22 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified  
23 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of  
24 the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
25 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary  
26 of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
27 Council.
