

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Assist Hickiwan District to)
(Solve Cadmium Problem)

RES. NO. 26-84

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is responsible for the health and welfare of
2 its members; and
3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been apprised of the contamination of the
4 Hickiwan and Vaya Chin water supply by the presency of Cadmium, a
5 poison; and
6 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council has by Resolution sought the assistance
7 of the Papago Tribe to take remedial steps immediately to remove
8 the Cadmium.


7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Papago Council that it does hereby
8 support the Hickiwan District in its efforts to remove the poison
9 Cadmium from the Hickiwan and Vaya Chin water supply;

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,
10 will identify any appropriate officials and direct them to take
11 whatever steps are necessary to assist the Hickiwan District in
12 its efforts to remove the Cadmium from the water supply.


12 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th
13 day of February, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
14 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant
15 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (h) and (m) of
16 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
17 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
18 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16
19 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject
20 to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date
21 of its enactment by the Papago Council.
