

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


(Modification of Title XX Grant)
(Child Day Care)



1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has consistently supported the
2 nurturment of its young members by providing for
3 their welfare through various programs and services
4 designed to meet their special needs:
5 WHEREAS, The Child Day Care services program has been success-
6 fully operated through the Early Childhood department
7 and has served many young Papago children; and
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is desirious of continuing this
9 program for the benefit of its young members; and
10 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has previously applied for, and re-
11 ceived funding to operate the Child Day Care services
12 program from the Department of Economic Security,
13 Block Grant Administration, Title XX; and
14 WHEREAS, the Department of Economic Security has requested an
15 amendment to the original Contract to modify the
16 funding and service requirements of the original
17 Contract; and
18 WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts office has reviewed the
19 proposed amendment to the original contract and finds
20 the same to be of benefit to the Child Day Care services
21 program;
22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
23 hereby approve and ratify the Contract amendment for
24 Title XX services and that it further reaffirms its
25 original approval and Ratification of the initial
26 Contract; and
27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore,
28 Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice-Chairman or Rosita N.
29 Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are authorized
30 to negotiate and execute any and all contracts,
31 amendments and documents necessary to secure funding
32 for the continued operation of the Day Care program.
The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council
on the 28 day of February, 1984 at a meeting at which a
quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; 0 against;
0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the
authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(m) of
Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe
of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on
December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject
to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
