

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Amendment of Ordinance 01-84)
(Vi-iakam Doag Industries)


1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did on February 8, 1984, by Resolution, Charter
2 the Vi-ikam Doag Industries, Inc., as a non-profit corporation
3 pursuant to Article V, Section 3 (g) of the Papago Constitution;
4 WHEREAS, the Articles of Incorporation omitted the names of the Board of
5 Directors and the Statutory Agent;
6 WHEREAS, the Charter is ineffective unless complete information is provided;
7 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Papago Council that the Vi-Ikam Doag
8 Industries, Inc., is hereby chartered as a non-profit Corporation,
9 incorporated to carry on in accordance with its stated purposes and
10 directed by a Board of five (5) Directors, to wit:



16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
17 day of March, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 1317.5 for; -0- against; 122.5 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant
19 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (m),
20 Section 3 (g) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe
of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,
and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


