6	and manage tribal funds in a manner to ensure that tribal projects						
7	are adequately funded; and WHEREAS, the Papago Council finds that in light of the bleak future of						
	projected revenues fiscal management of available monies must be						
8	carried out.						
9	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby accept						
10	the recommendation of the Comptroller to invest the monies left over						
11	from Fiscal Year 1983 and directs that the monies be invested with						
12	an appropriate financial institution;						
	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the monies will be available						
13	for use during the Fiscal Year 1985 budget process if needed.
