

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Invest Left Over Monies From Fiscal Year 1983 To Be Available)
(In Fiscal Year 1985)

RES. NO. 34-84

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised by the Comptroller of the Papago
2 Tribe of left over monies from Fiscal Year 1983; and

3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is concerned about the likely prospect that
4 future revenues will not be available and tribal services will be
5 cut; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is mandated by the Papago Constitution to control
7 and manage tribal funds in a manner to ensure that tribal projects
8 are adequately funded; and


9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council finds that in light of the bleak future of
10 projected revenues fiscal management of available monies must be
11 carried out.

12 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby accept
13 the recommendation of the Comptroller to invest the monies left over
14 from Fiscal Year 1983 and directs that the monies be invested with
15 an appropriate financial institution;


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the monies will be available
17 for use during the Fiscal Year 1985 budget process if needed.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
19 day of March, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
20 of 1185.5 for; 229.0 against; 25.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant
21 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (m),
22 and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the
23 Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December
24 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
25 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
26 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent
27 of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


