

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Acceptance of Budget & Finance Committee's
Recommendation to Conduct Workshop to Review
Future Economic Development)


RES. NO. 35-84

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is empowered by the Papago Constitution to manage
2 the economic affairs of the Papago Tribe; and
3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did delegate to the Budget & Finance Committee
4 specific tasks, one of which states that the Budget & Finance
5 Committee will develop sound budgets in accordance with priorities
6 established by the Papago Council by reviewing projected revenues
7 and available resources; and
8 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance has been advised that projected revenues now
9 available to the Papago Tribe will decrease and in some instances
10 will end; and
11 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee has discussed ways in which the
12 Papago Tribe can generate revenue for the Tribe; and
13 WHEREAS, an economic development workshop is needed to inform the Papago
14 Council of the considerations and areas of economic development
15 which may be appropriate for the Papago Tribe.


16 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby accept
17 the recommendation of the Budget & Finance Committee to conduct a
18 workshop to discuss and learn about economic development prospects.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
20 day of March, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to
22 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (m), and
23 Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago
24 Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12,
25 1963, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
26 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
27 Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is
28 effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
