

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Support for Construction of New High School)

RES. NO. 36-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has consistently voiced its support for the
2 education of its members through a meaningful education process; and
3 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe in order to attain this objective, has had to place
4 many of its young members in boarding schools away from the Papago
homeland; and

5 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe believes strongly that its children should be
6 educated in their home communities; and

7 WHEREAS, There is well supported evidence of the need for a high school on
the reservation; and

8 WHEREAS, Intermountain Indian School will close in June, 1984, and there is
9 strong evidence of the eventual closure of Phoenix Indian School,
actions that will displace over 500 Papago high school students; and

10 WHEREAS, There is support by the Congressional delegation for the funding
11 of a new high school on the Papago Reservation as evident by the
12 action of Congressman Udall to add \$10,000,000 to the Interior
13 budget for fiscal year 1985 to fund the construction of the high
school.

14 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby urges the
15 the Honorable Congressman Yates and the members of the Appropriations
16 Committee of the United States Congress to fund the construction
17 of the proposed high school to be located in the western area of
the Papago Reservation in the amount of \$10,000,000, as recommended
18 by Congressman Udall to the House Budget Committee; and


19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that in light of the imminent
20 closure of two key boarding schools heavily attended by Papago
21 students, i.e., Intermountain and Phoenix Indian Schools, construction
22 of the high school must begin immediately and to avoid disruption
23 in the education of students and to enhance a smooth transition,
the Papago Council respectfully urges the Honorable Congressman
24 Yates and the members of the Appropriations Committee to accept the
recommendation from Congressman Udall that funding be appropriated
at the beginning of the fiscal year 1985; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,
26 Francisco Jose, Vice Chairman, of the Papago Tribe or their
27 authorized delegate take all necessary steps to follow through on
28 securing the funds for the construction of the high school in fiscal
year 1985.


29 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
30 day of March, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
31 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to
32 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d), (f), (h),
(k), and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe
of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and

1 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
2 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not
3 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of
4 the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
