


- 1 WHEREAS, The Papago Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs has submitted to the
- 2 Papago Council the projected funding amounts for FY-1986; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is required to establish Agency program
- 4 priorities and set program funding and staffing levels by using the
- 5 Decision Ranking chart; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Decision Ranking chart allows the Papago Tribe to participate
- 7 in the Federal Budget process and to allocate resources in the most
- 8 cost efficient manner which will provide maximum services and
- 9 benefits for its members; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the decision units and is satisfied
- 11 that the following Decision Ranking chart is appropriate.

- 13 2. Law Enforcement 12. Self Determination
- 14 3. Tribal Courts 13. Administration Services
- 15 4. Social Services 14. Agriculture Extension

- 31 7. Tribal Government 17. Realty
- 32 8. Adult Education 18. Executive Direction
- 9. Individual Indian Monies
- 10. Employment Assistance

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd  
2 day of March, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
3 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant  
4 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of Article V of  
5 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
6 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
7 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
8 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
9 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
10 the Papago Council.
