

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Timely Payments of Per Capita Distribution)

RES. NO. 38-84

1 WHEREAS, The P.L. 97-408, signed into law on January 3, 1983, provides
2 for the use and distribution of judgment funds awarded to the
3 Papago Tribe in dockets numbered 345 and 102 of the Indian Claims
4 Commission, and requires the Secretary of the Interior to make
5 initial per capita distribution of \$1,000.00 to members of the
6 Tribe whose membership applications were approved by this Council
7 on or before January 3, 1983, within forty-five (45) days after
8 the date of certification by the Secretary of their eligibility
9 to share therein, and to members of the Tribe whose applications
10 were approved by the Council after January 3, 1983, within ninety
11 (90) days after their applications have been approved by this
12 Council and their eligibility to share therein had been certified
13 by the Secretary; and

14 WHEREAS, the purpose of the Act was to make per capita distributions
15 immediately available to members of the Papago Tribe whose
16 applications have been approved by the Council and whose
17 eligibility to share has been certified by the Secretary without
18 waiting for the completion of a corrected base roll or of the
19 membership roll; and

20 WHEREAS, the Papago Enrollment Office has worked diligently to certify
21 applications in a timely manner and has forwarded lists of
22 certified members to the Phoenix Area Office for processing of a
23 payment roll for payout by the Albuquerque Area Office; and

24 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised of the Bureau of Indian
25 Affairs' plans to shut down the ADP system to prepare for transfer
26 to the Burroughs computer system, which will result in a delay
27 in the April 19, 1984, per capita payout.


28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Phoenix Area
29 Office and the Albuquerque Area Office are directed to make per
30 capita distribution to members of the Papago Tribe as scheduled
31 and that there be no delays in either certification or
32 distributions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Phoenix and
Albuquerque Area Offices, delay the transition of computer systems
in order to meet the distribution date of April 19, 1984, and to
maximize the investment interest or income accruing to the funds
held and administered by the Secretary for per capita distributions
under the Act.


The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the
22nd day of March, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
a vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent
pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a),
(d), and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago

1 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
2 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
3 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
ment by the Papago Council.
