

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Authorization for Tribal Legal Counsel to Develop Ordinance
to Regulate Per Capita Distributions)

RES. NO. 39-84


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council reviews applications for tribal membership and
2 approves their membership and their eligibility to share in per
3 capita distributions; and
4 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has advised the Papago Council that several
5 individuals have received two per capita payments; and
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has authorized only one payment of \$1,000.00 to
7 all eligible members; and
8 WHEREAS, the individuals receiving double payments are required to report and
9 return the second check; and
10 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Check and the Bureau of Indian Affairs has been
11 unsuccessful in its attempt to require the return of the second
12 payment from these individuals; and
13 WHEREAS, in the same context, the Papago Council has learned of cases wherein
14 adoptions are being processed clearly with the intent to defraud the
15 Papago Tribe into making per capita payments to adopted persons;
16 WHEREAS, both these situations require the assistance of the Tribal Attorneys
17 to develop lawful means of remedying and prohibiting this type of
18 fraud.
19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs
20 the Tribal Attorneys to investigate the two situations and develop,
21 if necessary, ordinances to remedy the above referenced cases and
22 to prohibit and prescribe penalties for any future unlawful or illegal
23 acts which may occur.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 27th
25 day of March, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
26 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
27 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (b), (f), and (m) of
28 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
29 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
30 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
31 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
32 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
