RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Authorization for Tribal Legal Counsel to Develop Ordinance to Regulate Per Capita Distributions)

1	WHEREAS, the Papago Council reviews applications for tribal membership and							
2	approves their membership and their eligibility to share in per capita distributions; and							
3	WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has advised the Papago Council that several							
4	individuals have received two per capita payments; and							
5	WHEREAS, the Papago Council has authorized only one payment of \$1,000.00 to all eligible members; and							
6	WHEREAS, the individuals receiving double payments are required to report and							
7	return the second check; and							
8	WHEREAS, the Enrollment Check and the Bureau of Indian Affairs has been							
9	unsuccessful in its attempt to require the return of the second payment from these individuals; and							
10	WHEREAS, in the same context, the Papago Council has learned of cases wherein							
11	adoptions are being processed clearly with the intent to defraud the							
12	Papago Tribe into making per capita payments to adopted persons;							
	WHEREAS, both these situations require the assistance of the Tribal Attorneys							
13	to develop lawful means of remedying and prohibiting this type of fraud.							
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs							
15	the Tribal Attorneys to investigate the two situations and develop,							
16	if necessary, ordinances to remedy the above referenced cases and							
17	to prohibit and prescribe penalties for any future unlawful or illegal							
18	acts which may occur. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>27th</u> day of March, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1440.0</u> for; <u>-0-</u> against; <u>-0-</u> not voting; and <u>2</u> absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (b), (f), and (m) of
