

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Review May, 1984 Tribal Council Meeting
Plans for a Water Commission to handle all water related Issues

RES. NO. 44-84

1 WHEREAS, The Water Commission was established pursuant to Resolution No. 44-84
2 to carry out certain duties and responsibilities as they relate to the
3 water issues and concerns of the Papago Tribe; and

4 WHEREAS, The Water Commission actively participated in the development and
5 settlement of the Papago Tribe's water rights claims as provided in
6 the Southern Arizona Water Rights Act of 1982; and


7 WHEREAS, The Water Commissioners have acquired certain knowledge of the com-
8 plexity of water laws and issues and have the interest to continue to
9 monitor and address the Tribe's water issues and concerns; and

10 WHEREAS, The Papago Council finds it desirable to involve the water commission
11 in all negotiations and proceedings concerning the settlement of
12 San Lucy and Sif Oidak (Chuichu) water issues;


13 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs and
14 authorizes the Water Commission as established by Resolution No. 18-80
15 to actively participate in the negotiations and discussions concerning
16 the San Lucy and Sif Oidak water issues and in any other water-related
17 matters which may arise under or as a direct result of any legislation
18 concerning the water rights of the Papago Tribe.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th
20 day of April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 269.5 for; 0 against; 170.5 not voting; and 0 absent,
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f)
23 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
24 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
25 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
26 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
27 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
28 enactment by the Papago Council.
