RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Review May, 1984 Tribal Council Meeting Plans for a Water Commission to handle all water related Issues

RES. NO. 44-84

WHEREAS, The Water Commission was established pursuant to Resolution No. $\underline{44-84}$ to carry out certain duties and responsibilities as they relate to the water issues and concerns of the Papago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Water Commission actively participated in the development and settlement of the Papago Tribe's water rights claims as provided in the Southern Arizona Water Rights Act of 1982; and

WHEREAS, The Water Commissioners have acquired certain knowledge of the complexity of water laws and issues and have the interest to continue to monitor and address the Tribe's water issues and concerns; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council finds it desirable to involve the water commission in all negotiations and proceedings concerning the settlement of San Lucy and Sif Oidak (Chuichu) water issues;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs and authorizes the Water Commission as established by Resolution No. 18-80 to actively participate in the negotiations and discussions concerning the San Lucy and Sif Oidak water issues and in any other water-related matters which may arise under or as a direct result of any legislation concerning the water rights of the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the $\underline{4th}$ day of April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $\underline{269.5}$ for; $\underline{0}$ against; $\underline{170.5}$ not voting; and $\underline{0}$ absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section $\underline{2}$ (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
