1 WHEREAS, the implementation of Title III of P. L. 97-293 (The "Act) requires 2 engineering technical services which are not the obligation of the United States under the Act or any other act of Congress; and 3 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe also needs engineering technical services required in 4 the preparation of the new water settlement legislation that will settle 5 water right claims and result in the subjugation of land, development of water resources and the construction, operation, maintenance, and 6 replacement of related facilities within the Sif Oidak District and 7 the San Lucy District; and 8 WHEREAS, these engineering technical services will include, but are not necessarily limited to; (1) assistance with the development and preparation 9 of P. L. 93-638 contracts for engineering and related services and 10 Memoranda of Understanding between the Bureau of Reclamation and the 11 Papago Tribe required to implement Title III P. L. 97-293; (2) reviewing existing facilities at San Xavier Cooperative Farms and 12 assisting with the preparation of P. L. 93-638 contracts to extend and 13 improve its facilities; (3) engineering, hydrological and technical 14 assistance associated with the preparation of water settlement legislation for Sif Oidak District and Gila Bend Reservation (San Lucy District 15 and (4) any other civil engieering technical services which may be re-16 quired by the Tribe in its development and management of its water 17 resources and land associated therewith; and WHEREAS, the firm of Franzoy, Corey & Associates is well informed about all of 18 the above matters and has the necessary technical capabilities to 19 support the Tribe's efforts in the implementation of Title III of 20 P. L. 97-293 and in the preparation of technical information required for new water settlement legislation for the Sif Oidak District and 21 the San Lucy District (Gila Bend Reservation); and 22 WHEREAS, because of the Tribe's immediate need, the firm of Franzoy, Corey & 23 Associates has provided the Tribe with such services, for which they have not been paid; and 24 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe that the firm of Franzoy 25 Corey & Associates be retained under contract to provide the Tribe 26 with such required engineering technical services; and WHEREAS, income from the trust fund authorized and established under Section 27309 of P. L. 97-293 and Ordinance No. 03-83 of the Papago Council is

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council approves the attached budget to cover the costs and expenses of such contract and directs that they shall be paid from the Papago P. L. 97-293 Trust-Income accounts established and maintained pursuant to Ordinance No. 03-83.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th $10 \mid \mathsf{day}$ of April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1109.5 for; 114.5 against; 216.0 not voting; and pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (h), (m) and Section 3 (a) (h) of Aricle V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago 12 Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to 13 | Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
