

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL


Change the title of the Proposed  
Constitution from "Papago Nation" to "Tohono  
O'Odham Nation"


1 WHEREAS, The Constitution Committee of the Papago Council has presented a  
2 final draft of a proposed Constitution for the Papago Tribe to the  
3 Papago Council for review and approval; and  
4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed certain provisions and finds that  
5 it is desirable to make necessary changes at this point; and  
6 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has discussed at great length the title of  
7 "The Papago Nation" and reviewed the history behind the name; and  
8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes it would be in the best interest of the  
9 people and the Tribe as sovereign nation to choose what name it  
10 will call itself; and  
11 WHEREAS, Since time immemorial so-called Papagos has called themselves  
12 "O'odham of the desert or "Tohono O'odham;  
13 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby changes  
14 the reference of "Papago" anywhere in the proposed Constitution to  
15 read "Tohono O'odham".

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
13 day of April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
14 vote of 1037.5 for; 222.5 against; 180.0 not voting; and 0 absent,  
15 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f)  
16 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
17 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
18 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
19 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
20 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of  
21 the date of its enactment by the Papago Council
