
WHEREAS, The Constitution Committee of the Papago Council has presented a final draft of a proposed Constitution of the Papago Tribe, rescinding the 1937 Papago Constitution and By-laws; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed Constitution and believes it would be in the Tribe's best interest to make the following changes to better enable the Papago Tribe to fully exercise its sovereign rights and powers.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby change Article VI (6), Section 1 (i) to read. . . "Consult with the Congress of the United States and other appropriate federal agencies". . . .

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th day of April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
