


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Baboquivari District's FY '84 Budget Amendment)  
(Without the R.V. Parking Lot)


1 WHEREAS, The Baboquivari District Council did on March 10, 1984, meet and  
2 found that an additional \$84,366.38 was needed to complete several  
3 District projects; and  
4 WHEREAS, There is sufficient funds in the District's I.I.M. Account to cover  
5 the additional cost of completing the projects; and  
6 WHEREAS, The Baboquivari District Council did amend by Resolution No. 04-84  
7 its FY '84 budget to include \$84,366.38; and  
8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed budget and approves  
9 of the same with the exception of the R.V. Parking Lot portion  
10 totalling \$18,866.73; and  
11 WHEREAS, There is sufficient funds in the I.I.M. Account to cover the  
12 additional amounts proposed to be added to the FY '84 budget.  
13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby approves  
14 the addition of \$65,499.65 to Baboquivari's FY '84 budget to be  
15 expended in accordance with the attached budgets with the exception  
16 of the R.V. Parking Lot and for the projects identified by the  
17 District Council.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
19 day of April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
20 of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant  
21 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of Article  
22 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
23 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
24 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
25 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the  
26 date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject  
27 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


