

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Authorizing Attorney Contract for Sonoran Papagos

RES. NO. 52-84

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has consistently, since 1976, voiced its support  
 2 and concern for the welfare and problems of the Sonoran Papagos, the  
 3 O'Odham of Mexico, and;  
 4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has through formal resolution directed the officials  
 5 of the Papago Tribe to take whatever action is necessary to resolve the  
 6 problems and issues confronting the O'Odham of Mexico, and  
 7 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has contacted the Native American Rights Fund, a non-  
 8 profit law firm to request legal assistance in its negotiations and  
 9 dealings with the Mexican government; and  
 10 WHEREAS, the Native American Rights Fund, N.A.R.F., has agreed to contract with  
 11 the Papago Tribe, to act as and represent the Papago Tribe as attorneys  
 12 in negotiations with the Mexican government to resolve problems and  
 13 issues of the O'Odham of Mexico; and  
 14 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe and the Native American Rights Fund, N.A.R.F., agree  
 15 to be bound by the terms and conditions of a contract, incorporated  
 16 herein by reference and attached to this Resolution.  
 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby contracts  
 18 with, retains and employs the NATIVE AMERICAN RIGHTS FUND, N.A.R.F.,  
 19 a non-profit law firm located at 1506 Broadway, Boulder, Colorado,  
 20 80302, and its attorneys, to represent the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
 21 in the matters specifically provided in the attached Contract; and  
 22 for such terms as is provided for in the Contract.  
 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice Chairman  
 24 or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, are hereby authorized and directed to negoti-  
 25 ate and execute any and all documents, required and necessary, and any  
 26 amendments thereto.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day  
 28 April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1130.0  
 29 for; 310.0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the  
 30 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (b) and Section 3 (a) of  
 31 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
 32 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the  
 date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject  
 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
