Authorizing Attorney Contract for Sonoran Papagos

RES. NO. 52-84

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has consistently, since 1976, voiced its support and concern for the welfare and problems of the Sonoran Papagos, the 2 0'Odham of Mexico, and; 3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has through formal resolution directed the officials 4 of the Papago Tribe to take whatever action is necessary to resolve the problems and issues confronting the O'Odham of Mexico, and 5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has contacted the Native American Rights Fund, a non-6 profit law firm to request legal assistance in its negotiations and 7 dealings with the Mexican government; and WHEREAS, the Native American Rights Fund, N.A.R.F., has agreed to contract with 8 the Papago Tribe, to act as and represent the Papago Tribe as attorneys 9 in negotiations with the Mexican government to resolve problems and 10 issues of the O'Odham of Mexico; and WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe and the Native American Rights Fund, N.A.R.F., agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of a contract, incorporated 12 herein by reference and attached to this Resolution. 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby contracts with, retains and employs the NATIVE AMERICAN RIGHTS FUND, N.A.R.F., 14 a non-profit law firm located at 1506 Broadway, Boulder, Colorado, 15 80302, and its attorneys, to represent the Papago Tribe of Arizona 16 in the matters specifically provided in the attached Contract; and for such terms as is provided for in the Contract. 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice Chairman 18 or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, are hereby authorized an directed to negoti-19 ate and execute any and all documents, requried and necessary, and any amendments thereto. 20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day 21 April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of for: 310.0 against: 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to for; 310.0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (b) and Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
