

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
GU VO District 1983 Revenue Sharing Budget

RES. NO. 53-84

1 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Council did on January 18, 1984, by Resolution
2 No. 02-84, approve the expenditure of \$15,063.81 of General Revenue
3 Sharing monies; and
4 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Council identified that a housing rehabilitation
5 program would be funded with these funds, pursuant to certain criteria
6 established by the District Council; and
7 WHEREAS, The Papago Council finds that the housing rehabilitation program is
8 within the scope for which General Revenue Sharing funds may be used;
9 and
10 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the attached budget and finds the
11 same to be in order;
12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve
13 the expenditure of General Revenue Sharing Funds in the amount of
14 \$15,063.81 in accordance with the attached budget, for the purpose
15 identified by the Gu Vo District Council and in coordination with the
16 office of Revenue Sharing.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
18 day of April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a)
21 of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
22 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12 1936, and approved
23 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
25 the date of its approval by the Supperintendent of the Papago Agency and is
26 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
