

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Accept recommendation of the Constitution Committee to amend Article VI, "Powers of the Council", Section 1, Subsection (d), Subparagraph 4:

1 WHEREAS, The Constitution Committee of the Papago Council has presented a
2 final draft of a proposed Constitution for the Papago Tribe to the
3 Papago Council for review and approval; and

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed final draft section by
5 section and finds that it is desirable to make certain necessary
6 changes at this point,

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby accepts
8 the recommendation of the Constitution Committee to amend Article VI,
9 "Powers of the Council", Section 1, Subsection (d), Subparagraph 4:

10 FROM:


11 - to levy duties, fees, taxes and assessments on my
12 person, corporation, or association residing or
13 doing business within the Papago Nation

14 TO:


15 - to levy duties, fees, and assessments on any
16 person, corporation or association residing or
17 doing business within the Papago Nation; and for
18 such purposes, to establish assessment, tax, fee
19 or duty zones and districts.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 26th
21 day of April, 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
22 vote of 669.5 for; 415.0 against; 355.5 not voting; and 1 absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and
24 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
25 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
26 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
27 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
28 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of
29 the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
