WHEREAS, The Constitution Committee of the Papago Council has presented a final draft of a proposed Constitution for the Papago Tribe to the Papago Council for review and approval; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed final draft section by section and finds that it is desirable to make certain necessary changes at this point,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby accepts the recommendation of the Constitution Committee to amend Article VI, "Powers of the Council", Section 1, Subsection (d), Subparagraph 4: FROM:

> - to levy duties, fees, taxes and assessments on my person, corporation, or association residing or doing business within the Papago Nation

- to levy duties, fees, and assessments on any person, corporation or association residing or doing business within the Papago Nation; and for such purposes, to establish assessment, tax, fee or duty zones and districts.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the vote of 660 pril , 19.84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a 669.5 for; 415.0 against; 355.5 not voting; and 1pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
