

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Amend Article IX, "District Council Organization"  
Section 6

1 WHEREAS, The Constitution Committee of the Papago Council has presented a  
2 final draft of a proposed Constitution for the Papago Tribe to the  
3 Papago Council for review and approval; and  
4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed final draft section by  
5 section and finds that it is desirable to make certain necessary  
6 changes at this point.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby Amend  
8 Article IX, "District Council Organization" Section 6

9 FROM:


10 Section 6. Each District Council shall, within ten (10) days after  
11 its regular council meeting, submit copies of its minutes to the  
12 office of the Secretary of the Papago Council.

13 TO:


14 Section 6. Each District Council shall, within ten (10) days after  
15 formal approval of council minutes and resolutions, submit copies  
16 to the office of the Secretary of the Papago Council.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 26th  
18 day of April, 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
19 vote of 1185.5 for; 122.0 against; 132.5 not voting; and 3 absent,  
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and  
21 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
22 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
23 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
24 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
25 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of  
26 the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
