## Base Roll Additions

## RES. NO. <u>68-84</u>

1	WHEREAS, Section I (a) of Article II of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe
2	as amended, provides that the Papago Council can make additions and
3	changes to the official census rolls of the Sells and Gila Bend
	Reservations dated January 1, 1937, and of the San Xavier Reservation
4	dated January 1, 1940, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior; and
5	WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has determined that the following named
6	persons were members of the Papago Tribe on the date of the respective
7	census rolls but that their names had been inadvertently omitted
8	therefrom, and has recommended that their names be added to the rolls;
9	and
10	WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendations of the Enrollment Committee and approves thereof.
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, subject to the
	approval of the Secretary of the Interior, the names of the following
12	persons be added to the official census rolls of the Sells, Gila Bend
13	or San Xavier Reservation, to wit:
14	796-GV-75 WEYRAUCH, Maria Cruz (Ortiz)
15	1047-SO-75 PABLO, Josie
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the required approval be secured from the Secretary of the Interior before their names be formally added to
17	such rolls.
18	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 27th
19	day of <u>April</u> , 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1318.0 for; -O- against; -O- not voting; and <u>6</u> absent,
20	pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Article II and Article V, Section 2 (f) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe
21	of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
	Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not
22	subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
