

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Adoption into Tribal Membership

RES. NO. 69-84

1 WHEREAS, BUITIMEA, Margaret (Leon), ESPINOZA, Nicholas, ROBLES, Victoria  
2 (Espinoza), GARCIA, George N. have made application for adoption  
3 into Tribla membership pursuant to Section 2 of Article II of the  
4 Constitution of the Papago Tribe; and

4 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed their respective applications,  
5 has made a final determination that they are 1- $\frac{1}{2}$  degree or more of  
6 Papago Indian blood, and have made a recommendation to the Papago  
7 Council that their applications be approved, all in accordance with  
8 the provisions with the Papago Enrollment Ordinance; and

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation of the Enrollment  
9 Committee and the evidence submitted in support of the individual  
10 applications.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the applications  
11 for adoptions filed by BUITIMEA, Margaret (Leon), ESPINOZA, Nicholas,  
12 ROBLES, Victoria (Espinoza), GARCIA, George N. are hereby approved and  
13 they are hereby adopted into membership of the Papago Tribe.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 27th  
14 day of April, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
15 vote of 1379.0 for; -0- against; 61.0 not voting; and 3 absent,  
16 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Article II and  
17 Article V, Section 2 (f) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe  
18 of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
19 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
20 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1834 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
21 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
22 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
