RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Amendment of Article X "Elections", Section 4 of the Proposed Papago Constitution)

RES. NO. 73-83

1 WHEREAS, The Constitution Committee of the Papago Council has presented a final draft of a proposed Constitution for the Papago Tribe to the 2 Papago Council for review and approval; and 3

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the proposed final draft section by section and finds that it is desirable to make certain necessary changes at this point;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby changes Article X "Elections", Section 4 of the proposed Papago Constitution from:

> "Section 4. The Papago Council shall appoint an Election Board consisting of one qualified voter from each District who is not a member of the Papago Council. The Election Board shall call and supervise all elections under this Constitution in accordance with the Election Ordinance."

to:

"Section 4. The Papago Council shall appoint an Election Board. The Election Board shall call and supervise all elections under this Constitution in accordance with the Election Ordinance."

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1333.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
