

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Amendment of Article 17, "Land Policy", Section 3)

RES. NO. 75-84

1 WHEREAS, the Constitution Committee of the Papago Council has presented a
2 final draft of a proposed Constitution for the Papago Tribe to the
3 Papago Council for review and approval; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the proposed final draft section by
5 section and finds that it is desirable to make certain necessary
6 changes at this point.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby changes
8 Article 17, "Land Policy", Section 3, from:


9 "Section 3. Inasmuch as the lands of the Papago Nation are
10 held in common, District boundaries shall not prevent any member
11 of the Papago Nation from going into any District to live or
12 beneficially use the lands as members have done in years past."

13 to:


14 "Section 3. Inasmuch as the lands of the Papago Nation are held
15 in common, District boundaries shall not prevent any member of
16 the Papago Nation from going into any District to live or
17 beneficially use the lands in accordance with customary procedures
18 of the District."

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
20 day of May, 1984, at a meetin at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1333.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) of Article V
23 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
25 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
26 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
27 the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
28 by the Papago Council.
