RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Chief Judge Position (requirements legal background/bi-lingual

WHEREAS, the Papago Judicial system has enormous potential and significance for the welfare of the Papago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the office of Chief Judge is such that it demands that minimum qualifications be established to enable the judge to carry out his/her duties in a competent manner; and

WHEREAS, the qualifications required under the Law and Order code are not reflective of the nature of expertise and skills demanded by the position,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby amends the qualification requirements for the office of Chief Judge to include a qualification requirement that;

---- a minimum be set by the Law and Order Committee of legal experience or training to be required before any applicant is considered for the position;

--- the applicant be bilinqual, speaking Papago (0'otham) and English;
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these additional qualifications will be incorporated into the job description announcement of the position of Chief Judge.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1140.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in teh Papago Council by Section 2 (e) (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
