

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

( Chief Judge Position )  
( requirements legal background/bi-lingual )

Res. No. 77-84

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Judicial system has enormous potential and significance for  
2 the welfare of the Papago Tribe; and

3 WHEREAS, the office of Chief Judge is such that it demands that minimum  
4 qualifications be established to enable the judge to carry out his/her  
5 duties in a competent manner; and

6 WHEREAS, the qualifications required under the Law and Order code are not  
7 reflective of the nature of expertise and skills demanded by the  
8 position,

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby amends the  
10 qualification requirements for the office of Chief Judge to include  
11 a qualification requirement that;


12 ---- a minimum be set by the Law and Order Committee of legal experi-  
13 ence or training to be required before any applicant is considered  
14 for the position;

15 ---- the applicant be bilingual, speaking Papago (O'otham) and English;


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these additional qualifications will be incorporated  
17 into the job description announcement of the position of Chief Judge.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th  
19 day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
20 of 1140.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent,  
21 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) (f)  
22 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
23 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
24 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
25 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
26 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
27 its enactment by the Papago Council.
