3	and civil rights by persons convicted of certain felonious crimes;

5	WHEREAS, The Papago Council is desirious of implementing the same type of							
6	policy for convicted felons but to the extent of denying or revoking							
	membership rights and privileges in the Papago Tribe; and							
7	WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognized its obligation to make informed decisions							
8	to avoid discriminatory or unfair decisions; and							
9	WHEREAS, The Papago Council is obligated to determine whether this proposed							
10	policy will be in violation or any laws or regulations. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby directs							
10	the Tribal Attorneys to render a legal opinion of the proposed policy							
11	of disenvolling tribal members who have been convicted of major crimes.							
12	the purpose being to deny or revoke any privileges or benefits							
13	associated with tribal membership.							
14	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th							
	day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the							
15	authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (1) of Article V							
16	of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary							
17	of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of							
18	June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by							
19	the Papago Council.
