WHEREAS, the Papago Council is cognizant of the lack of a Nursing Home facility to provide for the health care for our elderly, and;
WHEREAS, this situation creates an ever increasing need for the health care for our elderly and;
WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been made aware of certain monies available for training of para-professionals to provide home health services through the Department of Health and Human Services, and;
WHEREAS, this program would reduce the number of elderly being placed in Nursing Home off-reservation facilities and also increase services that presently are not met.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Papago Council does hereby approve and support any efforts to obtain monies from the Department of Health and Human Services for providing training for Home Health Services for the Elderly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman Francisco Jose Vice Chairman, and/or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all contracts or documents and any amendments thereto;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract will begin upon awarding of the funds and required contracts and will terminate upon expiration of the contract term.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of May, 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
