2	establishment of a position classification and pay for all employees
2	of the Papago Tribe and for the development of proper procedures to
3	implement and maintain such plan; and
4	WHEREAS, the position classification and pay scale adopted by the Papago Council
5	June 19, 1980 by resolution #48-80, is outdated and erroneous; and
6	WHEREAS, the Tribal Administration established a Salary Committee to develop
	a viable and current position classification and pay scale for all
7	employees, and
8	WHEREAS, the Salary Committee has submitted to the Papago Council a standardized
9	Salary schedule; and WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed materials submitted by and the recom-
10	mendations of the Salary Committee and believes it in the best interest
	of the Papago Tribe that they be implemented as of October 1, 1984.
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salary schedule, a copy is attached
12	hereto and made a part hereof, submitted to this Council by the Salary
13	Committee is hereby approved and adopted for FY-1985 to cover all
14	employees and elected officials of the Papago Tribe,
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned Salary Schedule is applicable
	to all Tribal employees and elected officials regardless of tenure in
16	the position in which they are currently employed, and
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Salary Schedule will comprise the new salary
18	base for all tribal employees and elected officials, and
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as the Tribal Council grants future cost of living
	Allowance Increases, the Base Salary Schedule will be increased in
20	the same percentage as the cost of living allowance, in all ranges and steps and
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cost of living allowance increases shall be
22	applied to all employees regardless of tenure in the position in which
23	they are currently employed, and
	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that implementation of the new schedule will be effected
24	October 1, 1984, subject to this Council's final review and approval
25	and pending availibility of funds.
26	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
27	day of May, 19 84, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 992.0 for; 394.5 against; 52.5 not voting; and 1 absent,
28	pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) (h) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
	Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
29	approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not
30	subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
