8	and discussion on the proposed ordinance; and WHEREAS, the aforementioned moratorium is scheduled to terminate on June 1,

	Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to						
18	Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago						
19	Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
