

RESOLUTION OF PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Extending Moratorium for Six Month which will temporarily suspend all land sales, land leases, and land developments in San Xavier with the exception of the exterior boundaries of the San Xavier District)

RES. NO. 85-84

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 105-83 declare a moratorium
2 on the sales, leases and developments of all lands within the
3 boundaries of the San Xavier Reservation to allow for the development
4 of land use plans and guides; and

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been presented with a draft of an ordinance
5 which would enable the individual Districts to enact land use and
6 zoning plans to efficiently and effectively develop District lands;
7 and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is desirous of receiving more in-depth information
8 and discussion on the proposed ordinance; and

8 WHEREAS, the aforementioned moratorium is scheduled to terminate on June 1,
9 1984, and will pose serious concerns for the San Xavier District
10 Council about land sales, leases and developments taking place before
11 completion of the land studies.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it hereby declares
12 and continues a moratorium on all land sales, leases and developments
13 within the San Xavier reservation with the exception of the exterior
14 boundaries of the San Xavier District for a period of six (6) months.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
15 day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 1290.0 for; 150.0 against; -0- not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant
17 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c), (h), and (m)
18 and Section 3 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago
19 Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936,
20 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
21 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
22 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
23 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
