## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Baboquivari and Gu Vo Land Acquisitions)

Res. No. <u>86-84</u>

1	WHEREAS, upon request by the Papago Tribe, two (2) proposed bill have been						
2	prepared for introduction into Congress that will add to the reserva-						
3	tion certain lands known as the Baboquivari Peak Wilderness Area and						
	Section 6, 7, 18, 19, 30, and 31, Township 18, South, Range 3 West						
4	Gila and Salt River Meridian, a copy of both bills are attached hereto and made a part hereof; and						
5	WHEREAS, Section (c) of each bill restricts the use of these lands by the						
6	Papago Tribe for traditional purposes only and except for these uses						
7	the land shall remain a wilderness area; and						
8	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe desires to have the right of input and consultation						
9	with the Secretary prior to the establishment of any regulations for						
	conservation purposes; and						
10	WHEREAS, the intorductions and enactment into law of these two (2) proposed						
11	bills would be in the best interest of the Papago Tribe.						
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the two (2) proposed bills attached hereto and made a part hereof declaring that the						
13	United States hold those certain lands described therein in trust for						
14	the Papago Tribe are hereby approved including the terms and conditions						
	set forth in Section (c) of each bill, provided that the Papago Tribe						
15	shall have the right of input and to consult with the Secretary prior						
16	to the establishment of any regulations for conservation purposes.						
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and other tribal						
18	officials take all steps necessary to have these two (2) bills in-						
19	troduced and processed through the Congress and enacted into law						
20	as soon as possible. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>22nd</u>						
	day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote						
21	of 1440.0 for; -O- against; -O- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d), and (1) of						
22	Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by						
23	the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to						
24	review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of						
25	its enactment by the Papago Council.
