WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its Tribal government and management, by operating a Police Commission in the amount of \$8,900.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the amount of at least \$252,800.00 for FY 1985 to be budgeted as reviewed and approved by the Tribal Council. Any remaining balance of grant funds will be budgeted for indirect cost.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence on October 01, 1984 and end September 30, 1985.

Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
