

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Acceptance of Tribal Management & Support Services
P. L. 93-638 Grant Budget

Res. No. 90-84

1 WHEREAS, Section 104(a) of P. L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds
2 for the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of tribal
3 government"; and

4 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$252,800.00 of FY 1985
5 funds for such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its Tribal
7 government and management, by operating a Tribal Management &
8 Support Services in the amount of \$47,621.00.


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the amount
10 of at least \$252,800.00 for FY 1985 to be budgeted as reviewed and
11 approved by the Tribal Council. Any remaining balance of grant funds
12 will be budgeted for indirect cost.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence on October
14 01, 1984 and end September 30, 1985.


15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah N. Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr.,
16 Vice Chairman, or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized to
17 negotiate and sign whatever grant documents are required and,
18 further, to negotiate and sign amendments and extensions to such
19 grant.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd
21 day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
22 of 645.5 for; 191.0 against; 603.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant
23 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d), and (m)
24 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
25 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
26 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16
27 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
28 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
29 enactment by the Papago Council.
