	Bureau of Indian Affairs; and							
3	WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the							
4	Papago Tribe and its people; and							
5	WHEREAS, 25 CFR Sec. 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all							
6	proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the							
	Tribal Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contrac							
7	termination; and							
8	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council does desire to recontract for provision							
9	of these services during FY 1985; and							
	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has reviewed and approved the Papago							
10	Children's Home contract.							
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize							
12	and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the							
13	Papago Tribe under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the							
	provision of services titled Papago Children's Home. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on							
14	October 01, 1984 and end September 30, 1985.							
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate							
16	programs from which contracts are requested herewith which have							
17	not been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs							
	prior to the start of the funding year.							
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr.,							
19	Vice Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council							
20	is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts							
21	and any amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts.							
	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd							
22	day of May, 1984, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -O- against; -O- not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the							
23	authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d), and (m) of							
24	Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by							
	the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of							
25	the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of							
26	its enactment by the Papago Council.
