

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Approving funding for Early Childhood Education for a period of 5 months in the amount of \$20,350.00)

RES. NO. 14-86

1 WHEREAS, The State of Arizona, through the Department of Education, has
2 demanded, as a requirement to the releasing of funds to the Tribe
3 under the Child Care Food Program, that all Early Childhood Headstart
4 employees and Tribal Day Care employees sign certain documents and
5 provide certain information to enable the State to check and screen
6 those employees; and

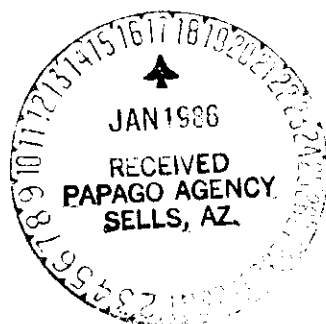
8 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe believes that it is their responsibility to do the
9 necessary screenings and background checking of its employees and to
10 turn this matter over to the State of Arizona would be a loss of
11 Tribal sovereignty; and

12 WHEREAS, This controversy has created a delay in acquiring the necessary
13 funds to operate a Child Care Food Program and this program has need
14 for \$20,350.00 to operate for the next five (5) months as set forth
15 in the budget attached hereto and made a part thereof.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Treasurer of the Papago Tribe is hereby
18 authorized and directed to fund the Child Care Food Program in the
19 amount of \$20,350.00 in accordance with the budget attached hereto
20 and made a part hereof.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
23 day of January, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
24 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
25 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(h) and 3(a) of Article V
26 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
27 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
