

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Opposition to Proposed Budget Deferrals and Rescissions for FY 86)

RES. NO. 170-86

1 WHEREAS, The Impoundment Control Act of 1974 authorizes the President to  
2 recommend to Congress budget deferrals or rescissions for agencies  
3 which have received appropriations; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, The President has proposed budget deferrals and rescissions to compli-  
6 ment the reductions mandated by the Balanced Budget and Emergency  
7 Deficit Control Act of 1985; and

8 WHEREAS, The rescissions will affect programs in the Department of Agriculture,  
9 Commerce, Education, Health and Human Services, Housing and Urban  
10 Development, Interior Justice, Labor Transportation and Treasury; and

11 WHEREAS, Tribal programs funded from these agencies include the Food Distri-  
12 bution program, Clinical services, CHR, Tribal Health Management,  
13 Indian housing, JTPA programs for summer youth, Native Americans and  
14 Job Corp., EDA and Revenue Sharing;

15  
16 WHEREAS, Any deferrals or rescissions of budget authority for these programs  
17 will severely impact the delivery of services to recipient members  
18 and effectively frustrate the tribe's efforts and goals in these  
19 areas; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, The President has not shown a compelling reason to target these  
22 particular programs even though they clearly meet basic human needs;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
24 strongly oppose any budget deferral or rescission of budget authority  
25 for FY 86 and urges Congress to review the merits of the President's  
26 proposal for such actions and restore the programs to full budget  
27 authority.

28 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 28th  
29 day of February, 1986 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
30 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
31 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (f) and (h) of Article  
32 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the




