

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(In Support of Bihinol Du'ag High School)

RES. NO. 173-86

1 WHEREAS, Congress has appropriated 9.5 million dollars in FY 85 for the con-
2 struction of Bihinol Du'ag High School (Papago High); and

3
4 WHEREAS, Construction of the high school has began and is expected to be com-
5 pleted by Fall, 1986; and

6 WHEREAS, The original development plans called for construction of student
7 cottages, housing units, playing fields and other incidental facili-
8 ties;


9 WHEREAS, I would be to the benefit of the Tribe and the prospective students to
10 seek funds to complete the high school as planned;

11 WHEREAS, A total of 1.9 million in additional construction dollars would be
12 needed to build student cottages, 8 housing units, a playing field, 10
13 trailer pads with hook-up capabilities, irrigation, and lighting
14 fixtures;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
17 request from Congress an additional 1.9 million dollars to construct
18 the above mentioned facilities at Bihinol Du'ag High School.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 28th
20 day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (f) and (h) of Article
23 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-
25 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
26 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
27 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
28 the Papago Council.
