RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Recommending G.A. to be included in Exempt Category)

RES. NO. 174-86

WHEREAS,	The Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (P. L.
	77-199) was passed by Congress and mandates deficit reductions by
	the fiscal year 1991; and

WHEREAS, Congress recognized the serve impact of this mandate on certain programs and provided for special treatment of certain programs including foster care, adoption assistance unemployment compensation, child support enforcement, etc., and Congress further exempted from sequestration eight low income programs; Medicaid, AFDC, WIC, SSI, FOOD STAMPS, CHILD NUTRITION, VETERANS COMPENSATION AND VETERANS PENSIONS: and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council urges and recommends to Congress to include in the exempt category General Assistance payments to indigent families because of the basis for this program, i.e. poverty, and because any reductions will severely impact eligible recipients; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Social Service program provides General Assistance payments using AFDC criteria for eligibility and would not be available from any other source if reduced or terminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby strongly support and urges Congress to consider and include the General Assistance payments in the exempt category protecting it from sequestration under the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the $\frac{28th}{a}$ day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $\frac{1225.0}{1225.0}$ for; $\frac{293.5}{1225.0}$ against; $\frac{121.5}{1225.0}$ not voting; and $\frac{01}{1225.0}$ absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (f) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
