

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Opposition to Proposed Reduction of Title II Indian  
Child Welfare Act Grants)

RES. NO. 176-86

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe contracts, pursuant to the authority of P.L. 93-638  
2 to provide social service programs to its eligible members; and  
3

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has consistently supported the strengthening of  
5 families and urge the development of programs designed to prevent the  
6 break-up of families and the removal of Indian children as evidenced  
7 by its Children's Court system and child welfare programs; and

8 WHEREAS, The Human Service department receives grant money under Title II of  
9 the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 to operate child welfare programs  
10 aimed at preventing the removal of children and break-up of families;  
11 and

13 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs is proposing to drastically reduce Title  
14 II grant funds to offset deficit reduction required by the Balanced  
15 Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985; and


16 WHEREAS, any reductions in Title II grant funds will greatly impact the  
17 delivery of needed services to those children and their families  
18 entitled to child welfare services and increase the overall cost of  
19 social services; and

21 WHEREAS, the effort and objectives of the Papago Human Services program to meet  
22 the intent and goal of the Indian Child Welfare Act will be  
23 frustrated.


24 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby oppose  
25 a the proposed reduction in Title II Indian Child Welfare Act funds to  
26 offset deficit reductions, and respectfully urges Congress to  
27 scrutinize the merits of this proposal by the Bureau of Indian Affairs  
28 taking into consideration the intent of the Indian Child Welfare Act  
29 of 1978 and those children and families intended to benefit by its  
30 passage.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 28th  
2 day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
3 of 1225.0 for; 293.5 against; 121.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
4 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (f) and (h) of Article  
5 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
6 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-  
7 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
8 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
9 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
10 the Papago Council.
