

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(In Support of a Master Contract for Health Services Delivery)



1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe currently contracts with the Indian Health Services
2 to provide several health care services; and
3
4 WHEREAS, The current policy of contracting has resulted in piecemeal contract-
5 ing contributing to administrative and operational deficiencies often
6 to the detriment of the tribal health programs; and
7
8 WHEREAS, A Master Contracting Plan to coordinate and facilitate the transfer
9 of all Indian Health Service programs through contract to the Tribe
10 would be most practical and contribute to sound human resources
11 development and enhance contract compliance; and

13 WHEREAS, This scheme would allow and encourage the Tribe to exercise
14 managerial and administrative control of health care delivery on the
15 reservation and make possible a reduction in Indian Health Service
16 administrative overhead; and

18 WHEREAS, This scheme would also facilitate the Tribe's intention of subcon-
19 tracting with private sector health care providers through competitive
20 bids or negotiated contracts. There by taking advantage of private
21 sectors cost efficiencies; and

23 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe would be willing to participate in a congressionally-
24 supported project testing this concept and urges favorable considera-
25 tion for an appropriation to allow this project;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
28 support a Master Contracting Plan to coordinate and administer all
29 Indian Health Services programs under a single master contract, and
30 to enable the Tribe to subcontract with private health care providers
31 through competitive bids or negotiated contracts for essential health
32 care services, and further The Papago Council urges and requests
Congress to support this concept and provide authorization for an
appropriation to test this concept for general application.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 28th day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote

1 of 1219.0 for; 183.5 against; 237.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
2 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (f) and (h) of Article
3 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
4 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-
5 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
6 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
7 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
8 the Papago Council.
