

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(In Support of Congressional Appropriation to Develop and
Implement a Model for Community-Oriented Primary Care (COPC))

RES NO. 182-86

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has consistently urged and supported the development
2 of innovative demonstration model health programs to enable delivery
3 of quality health care to its members; and

4
5 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has maintained a working relationship with the
6 Indian Health Service and has actively participated in demonstration
7 and experimental testing of new approaches to quality health care;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe, through its Health Department has developed
10 innovative ideas to design and implement a tribally-operated model
11 for community-oriented primary care which would enhance the role of
12 the Community Health Representatives (CHR) in the communities; would
13 promote prevention activities which in the long run would reduce the
14 use of acute care services and reduce, significantly, the high cost
15 of providing for acute care services; and

17 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe is desirous of demonstrating its commitment to
18 providing quality health care services to its eligible recipients
19 while at the same time developing programs which will be cost
20 efficient and effective; and

22 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has no resources to design and develop the
23 Community-Oriented Primary Care (COPC) project for actual use and is
24 requesting Congress to authorize funds for a demonstration model
25 project.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Papago Council that it does hereby
27 request and urge Congress to review the Papago Tribe's Community-
28 Oriented Primary Care concept for merit and authorize such funds as
29 will be necessary to design, test and implement the concept as a
30 working model to enhance the delivery of health care services for
31 Papago People to reduce the overall high cost of health care.




The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th

the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the
Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the
Papago Council.
